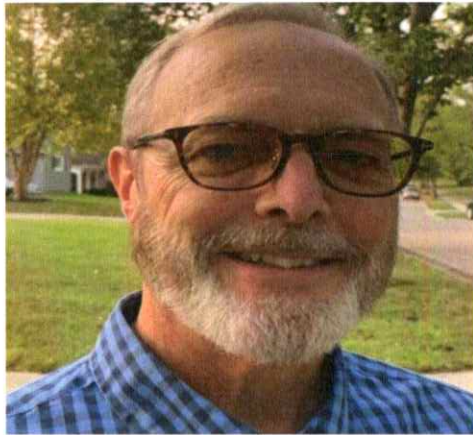


Jim Boerner



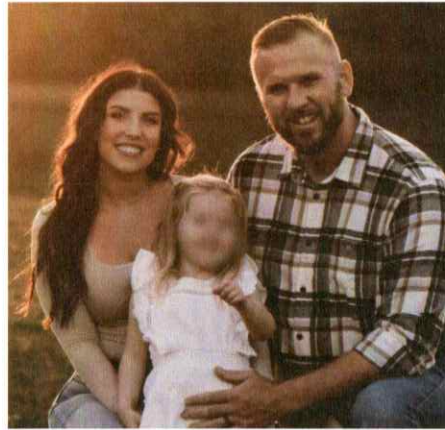

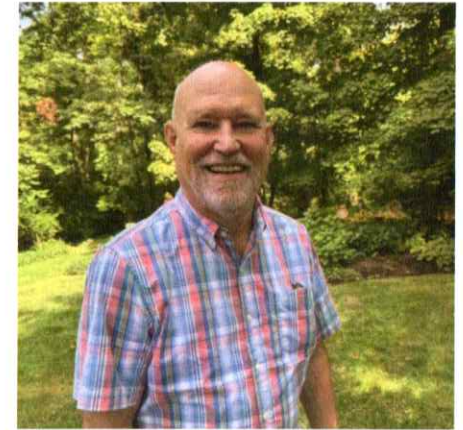
